Her professional experience also includes Senior Associate, Alpha Center, Washington, DC; Research Associate and Lecturer, Department of Health Policy and Management, University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill; Administrative Manager, New England Medical Center, Boston; and Health Policy Analyst and Program Director, New York State Department of Health.

Dr. Lamphere earned her doctorate in Health Policy and Management from Columbia University and is an Adjunct Associate Professor at the University of Maryland. In addition to being a noted author and frequent lecturer, she is a founding member of the Campaign for Effective Patient Care.
